#### Called to order at 6:33 PM

- 1) Prayer and meditation: Pastor Doug's devotion was inspired by our recent hymn "Take My Life That I Might Be".

## Pastor-Church Council Meeting, December 8, 2020

### 1) Property

- a) Anthony (and Antonio his son) are doing a great job.
- b) Security: The keys to the padlock are being distributed to those who need to get in. I have kept a list and it is with the undistributed keys in key box in Pastor's office.
- c) Louie has been weeding and cleaning around the outside of the church.
- d) We will need more sanitizing supplies and other virus protection items as we get more people into building for worship. I bought some the other day. We also need small trash can size trash bags.
- e) I had contacted Carlo and got him a key to gated area..
- f) The outside timer for the lights on porch and immediate side of building does not seem to be functioning correctly.

### 2) Worship

- a) We have opened up for in building worship, and doing ZOOM, since April/May.
- b) I am still putting together a weekly exposition of text and hymns for the members and have them to them before end of week either by email or mail.
- c) We will continue not having a fellowship time following worship for a while.
- d) Advent/Christmas
  - 1) We have been using the new Advent/Christmas Power Point
  - 2) There will be no midweek evening Bible study through Advent, like in the past.
  - 3) Christmas Eve Candlelight service will be at 7:00pm. What has been proposed is that we purchase some commercially individually packaged wine and bread sets, and put them in a plastic bag along with a candle,(and ZOOM info). Bags are done (thank you Aldredges), 100 of them. They can be picked up now.
  - 4) Hanging of the Greens is done and the Luminarias will be out Christmas Eve, thank you to Kristi A. getting the sets and Robert Hauge family and whomever else wants to help set them up and light them..
  - 5) Christmas Day service will be on Christmas Day at 10:30 am.
- e) Our Sunday weekly attendance (in house and ZOOM estimates) from January 1 to November 30, 2020, was 24.

# 3) Rocky Mountain Synod and ELCA

- a) We are working on getting the 2019 ELCA required changes into our constitution.
- b) We have been keeping up our regular contributions to the RMS (and ELCA).
- c) We will be starting in January to use electronic contribution forms with Synod office.

#### 4) Financials

Messiah in conjunction with Albertsons and KMS will be providing to 10 anonymous families of KMS approximately \$100 worth of staple food for said families. We can do more giving to help with hunger if we wish.

- b) Youth Gathering next summer in Minneapolis. Will keep you informed.
- c) Trunk or Treat in October will need to be thought through so we can still do it, if we wish and when. Possibly a Spring event.
- d) We do plan to start up slowly some of our regularly monthly activities.
  - 1) The Wednesday morning Bible study has been meeting since June 17, 2020. I clean the best I can and we meet well spaced out in the Fellowship Hall.
  - 2) The Men's Bible study will not begin for a few months.
  - 3) MLCW has chosen to wait for a while before starting up again.
  - 4) Sew and Share is still waiting to getting started. They will be finishing and making ready a high school graduation quilt for Thade H.
  - 5) Craft Club did have restarted their meetings since Wed. Night the 4<sup>th</sup> of Nov.

### e) Rising Sun Christian Community
